

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR PERSONS WITH CEREBRAL PALSY

GRANTS

1. The amounts allocated annually depends on the financial situation of the NAPCP at the given time.
2. Grants are only allocated to organisations and schools affiliated to NAPCP and whose annual affiliation fees are paid up to date at the time of allocation.
3. Grant information and application forms are circulated early in February each year and allocations are made following a meeting held in March.
4. Grants to assist individuals must be submitted on their behalf by the applicable affiliated organization/school/institution.
5. In the case of applications for assistance towards the purchase of assistive devices, quotes from suppliers must be submitted with the application forms.
6. The aim is to assist as many individuals as possible. The application will more likely be considered if it is for smaller items and smaller amounts rather than a single application for one device or one individual.
7. The decision in terms of the allocations is made by the Grants Committee of the NAPCP.

CRITERIA OF APPLICATIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL GRANTS

- ONLY for persons with cerebral palsy;
- For further development (study, skills etc.);
- For Use for persons with cerebral palsy for to sponsor feed/transport costs to attend day care centre or residential care;
- For adaptive assistive devices (walkers, splints, etc.);
- Limit on repeatability over 5 years
- Other criteria as may be determined
